Post Office Act 1993

POSTAL PACKETS (CUSTOMS AND EXCISE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2019

Approved by Tynwald: 22nd May 2019
Coming into Operation: in accordance with regulation 2

The Treasury makes the following Regulations under section 15(2) of the Post Office Act 1993.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Postal Packets (Customs and Excise) (Amendment) Regulations 2019.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald¹, these Regulations come into operation on exit day.

3 Interpretation

In these regulations “**exit day**” has the same meaning as in the European Union and Trade Act 2019.

4 Amendment of the Postal Packets (Customs and Excise) Regulations 2015

- (1) The Postal Packets (Customs and Excise) Regulations 2015² are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 3, omit the definition of “the customs territory”.
- (3) In regulation 13(b), in the substituted text, for “customs territory”, substitute **Island and the United Kingdom**.
- (4) In regulation 14, for “customs territory”, wherever occurring, substitute **Island and the United Kingdom**.
- (5) In regulation 18(1), omit “from outside the customs territory”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Postal Packets (Customs and Excise) Regulations 2015 (the “2015 Regulations”) as a consequence of the United Kingdom’s withdrawal from the European Union. The amendments come in to operation on exit day.

These Regulations omit the definition of “customs territory” in the 2015 Regulations and replaces references to the “customs territory” with references to the Island and the United Kingdom.
