*Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985*

SADDLE ROAD, DOUGLAS (PARKING PLACES DESIGNATION) ORDER 2019

Made: 10 May 2019
Coming into Operation: 14 May 2019

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985.

1 Title

This Order is the Saddle Road, Douglas (Parking Places Designation) Order 2019.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 14 May 2019.

3 Interpretation

(1) In this Order —

“**the Act**” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985;

“**Class A vehicles**” means motor cars (including dual purpose vehicles), invalid carriages, motor cycles with or without a sidecar, tricycles and light goods vehicles not exceeding 6 metres in length or 2 metres in height;

“**Department**” means Department of Infrastructure;

“**driver**”, in relation to a vehicle waiting in the parking place, means the person driving or riding the vehicle when it was left in the parking place;

“**emergency services’ vehicles**” means an ambulance, fire brigade vehicle or police vehicle during such time as the vehicle is in actual use for any emergency purpose, or a vehicle or trailer during such time as it is in actual use by any coastguard service provided by the Department for the purposes of giving aid to persons in danger or vessels in distress on or near the coast or a vehicle or trailer during such time as it is in actual use for civil defence or bomb disposal purposes;

“**exempted vehicle**” means a vehicle exempted from the provisions of this Order by virtue of article 6;

“**parking place**” means any part of a road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.

(2) Any reference in this Order to a class or description of vehicle is to be construed in accordance with the Road Traffic Act 1985.

4 Authorisation and use of parking place

The road specified in column 1 of the Schedule may be used, subject to article 5, as a parking place that vehicles may wait in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in the Schedule.

5 Conditions of use of the parking place

(1) The driver of a vehicle must stop the engine as soon as it is in position in the parking place and must not restart it except when about to change the vehicle’s position in, or to depart from, the parking place.

(2) The driver of a vehicle must not —

- (a) cause it to wait in the parking place unless it is parked within the limits of the parking place and parallel to the kerb;
- (b) cause a vehicle to wait in the parking place for longer than the maximum period of waiting specified in the Schedule; or
- (c) cause any vehicle to wait in the parking place, except a vehicle of a class specified in the Schedule.

(3) A person must not carry out or permit to be carried out on a vehicle in the parking place any maintenance or repair, unless it is necessary to enable the vehicle to be removed from the parking place.

(4) A person must not carry out or permit to be carried out any cleaning of a vehicle in the parking place.

(5) A person must not —

- (a) use any vehicle, or anything towed by a vehicle, whilst it is in the parking place, for the purpose of or in connection with —
 - (i) the sale or offer for sale of any article;
 - (ii) the offer of any service;
 - (iii) the hire or employment or offer for hire or employment of any person;
 - (iv) the display of any article; or
 - (v) sleeping or for habitation or any domestic purpose;
- (b) advertise for sale or hire any vehicle, while it is in the parking place;

- (c) store any trailer, caravan or other similar vehicle in the parking place;
 - (d) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent, booth, stand, building or other structure in the parking place; or
 - (e) unnecessarily sound the horn of any vehicle, nor make any loud noise by mechanical means or otherwise which may cause disturbance to other users of the parking place or to the occupiers of properties in the neighbourhood.
- (6) A person must not abandon a vehicle in the parking place.

6 Exemptions

The provisions of this Order do not apply to –

- (a) emergency services' vehicles; and
- (b) vehicles being used for or on Department business.

SCHEDULE

AUTHORISED ROADS IN DOUGLAS

[Article 4]

Roads authorised to be used as a parking place	Position in which a vehicle may wait	Permitted classes of vehicles	Days of operation of parking place	Period for which vehicles may wait
Saddle Road	West side - from a point 156 metres north of the north-western kerbline of Ballaughton Manor Hill for a distance of 192 metres in a northerly direction.	A	All days	Midnight to Midnight with a maximum stay of 16 hours in any 24 hours

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order designates a parking place on the west side of Saddle Road where Class A vehicles may wait for a period not exceeding 16 hours in any 24 hours.
