PAROCHIAL FEES (ISLE OF MAN) ORDER 2019

Coming into operation

1 January 2020

The Sodor and Man Diocesan Board of Finance makes this Order under section 4 of the Church Fees Measure (Isle of Man) 2014¹.

1. Title

This Order is the Parochial Fees (Isle of Man) Order 2019.

2. Commencement

If approved by the Sodor and Man Diocesan Synod, this Order comes into operation on 1 January 2020.

3. Interpretation

In this Order —

"the Board" means the Sodor and Man Diocesan Board of Finance;

"minister", in relation to a benefice, means the incumbent or priest in charge of the benefice.

4. Fees for occasional services etc.

- (1) The fees set out in Schedule 1 are prescribed as the fees due in relation to the matters there mentioned.
- (2) Those fees shall be payable as follows —
 - (a) a fee in the column headed "Board", to the Board;
 - (b) a fee in the column headed "Sexton" —
 - (i) to the sexton of the parish in question;

- (ii) where there is no sexton, to the person performing the duty of the sexton;
- (c) a fee in the column headed "PCC", to the parochial church council of the parish in question.

5. Fees for licences to marry

The fees set out in Schedule 2 are prescribed as the fees payable to the Bishop, Vicar General or surrogate for a licence to marry.

6. Fees for clergy and readers with PTO

- (1) The fees set out in Schedule 3 are prescribed as the fees payable —
 - (a) to a clerk in Holy Orders with permission to officiate, or
 - (b) except in the case of a service of Holy Communion or a marriage service, to a reader with permission to officiate,for officiating at the services there mentioned in the area of a benefice and making pastoral visits in connection therewith in the circumstances specified in paragraph (2) or (6).
- (2) A fee prescribed by paragraph (1) is payable —
 - (a) if the minister is absent;
 - (b) if the service in question takes place on a day falling within an uninterrupted rest period of 40 hours to which the minister is entitled under his or her terms of service;
 - (c) if the benefice is vacant and no priest in charge has been appointed.
- (3) A fee payable under paragraph (2)(a) is payable —
 - (a) by the Board, if the minister is absent on annual leave or on diocesan business;
 - (b) by the Board, if the minister is absent by reason of illness, provided that he or she pays to the Board the amount of any incapacity benefit to which he or she is entitled to receive in respect of the period of absence;
 - (c) by the minister, in any other case.
- (4) A fee payable under paragraph (2)(b) is payable by the Board.
- (5) A fee payable under paragraph (2)(c) is payable —
 - (a) by the Board, in the case of a funeral, marriage or baptism service;
 - (b) by the Board, in the case of any other services, but —

- (i) not exceeding 2 services at any one parish church on the same day, and
 - (ii) not exceeding 3 services at any one parish church in any week beginning on a Sunday;
 - (c) by the parochial church council of the parish in question, in the case of any other service held with the consent of the council.
- (6) A fee prescribed by paragraph (1) is payable by the Board for any service over and above 2 services on any Sunday in the area of a benefice, if no assistant curate or licensed reader is available to take any of the Sunday services.
- (7) Except in the case of a funeral service, in addition to a fee payable under paragraph (2) or (6) there are payable reasonable travelling expenses for attending the service and making allowable pastoral visits in connection with the service, for the actual distance travelled on each return journey —
- (a) if it is wholly within the mission partnership in which the area of the benefice in question lies;
 - (b) otherwise, to a maximum of 10 miles.

7. Revocation

The Parochial Fees (Isle of Man) Order 2017² is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order specifies fees payable for occasional church services, monuments in burial grounds and searches in church registers (Schedule 1), special and common licences for marriage (Schedule 2), and services performed in the minister's absence, or during a vacancy, by visiting clergy and readers with permission to officiate (Schedule 3).
