Emergency Powers Act 1936

EMERGENCY POWERS (POTENTIALLY INFECTIOUS PERSONS) (AMENDMENT) (REGULATIONS 2020)

Laid before Tynwald: 27 March 2020

Approved by Tynwald: 27 March 2020

Coming into Operation: in accordance with regulation 2

The Governor in Council by order makes the following Regulations under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Emergency Powers (Potentially Infectious Persons) (Amendment) (Regulations 2020).

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made¹.

3 Interpretation

In these Regulations “**the principal Regulations**” means the Emergency Powers (Potentially Infections Persons) Regulations 2020².

4 Principal Regulations amended

(1) Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 10 after paragraph (4) insert—

(4A) Despite a requirement imposed under paragraph (4) a person who is asymptomatic in relation to Coronavirus may leave the specified place in order to exercise provided that the person takes

all reasonable steps to remain at least 2 metres from any other person.

- (4B) Without limiting the generality of paragraph (4)(b) a person (“P”) who is self-isolating must notify the Department of the identity of every other person who is a member of his or her household and who lives with P by telephoning a telephone number for the time being specified by the Department. **22**.

- (3) For regulation 11 substitute—

11 Exception from self-isolation

- (1) Despite any other provision of these Regulations the Chief Secretary may, after consultation with the Department and the Director of Public Health permit a person, or a class of persons, who would otherwise be required to self-isolate not to do so if such conditions (if any) as are specified in the permission are met.
- (2) Conditions imposed under paragraph (1) must be notified to the persons affected in such manner as the Chief Secretary thinks appropriate in the circumstances. **22**.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Emergency Powers (Potentially Infectious Persons) Regulations 2020 (SD 2020/0171). The original regulation 11 set out in the Schedule to those Regulations is replaced by a provision which enables the Chief Secretary, subject to such conditions as he sees fit to grant exemption from the requirement to self-isolate to persons or classes of persons. They also permit a person who is asymptomatic but self-isolating to leave home in order to take exercise. They also impose requirements as to notification of the identity of other members of a self-isolating person's household.
