# EMERGENCY POWERS (CORONAVIRUS) (EVENTS AND GATHERINGS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020

*Laid before Tynwald: 21 April 2020*  
*Approved by Tynwald: 21 April 2020*  
*Coming into Operation: in accordance with regulation 2*

The Governor in Council makes the following Regulations under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.

## **1 Title**

These Regulations are the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

## **2 Commencement**

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made<sup>1</sup>.

## **3 Amendment of the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) Regulations 2020**

In regulation 3 of the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) Regulations 2020<sup>2</sup> — after the definition of “the Department” insert —

“gathering” means any meeting or assembly of two or more persons who are not members of the same household;”

<sup>1</sup> By virtue of section 4(2) of the Emergency Powers Act 1936, Regulations made under that section must be laid before Tynwald within 7 days of being made and only continue in force beyond 7 days of being so laid if Tynwald passes a resolution to that effect.
