EMERGENCY POWERS (CORONAVIRUS) (PROVISION OF TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2020

Laid before Tynwald: 12 May 2020
Approved by Tynwald: 12 May 2020
Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 2

The Governor in Council makes the following Regulations under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Provision of Temporary Accommodation) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made¹.

3 Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Provision of Temporary Accommodation) Regulations 2020 amended

- (1) The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Provision of Temporary Accommodation) Regulations 2020² are amended as follows.
- (2) In the licence to occupy in Part 2 of the Appendix –
 - (a) in clause 4.10, after “clean and tidy”, insert **“and condition 2”**; and
 - (b) in rule 14 of the Schedule (Coronavirus Provision of Temporary Accommodation At Sefton Hotel/Athol House Rules), for “I must ensure that any electrical item I have has a valid portable appliance test (PAT) certificate.”, substitute **“I agree to any electrical item I**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made by the Governor in Council under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936 and following a proclamation of a state of emergency under section 3 of that Act.

These Regulations are made for the purpose of securing the essentials of life to the community of the Island and for the protection of the economy of the Island.

These Regulations amend the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Provision of Temporary Accommodation) (Amendment) Regulations 2020 by correcting a typographical error and by removing the requirement for a temporary resident to produce a PAT certificate in relation to any electrical equipment that the resident brings into the accommodation.
