The Governor in Council makes the following Regulations under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Closure of Businesses and Other Premises) (Amendment) (No.5) Regulations 2020.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation on Monday 11 May 2020¹.

3 Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Closure of Businesses and Other Premises) Regulations 2020 amended

- (1) The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Closure of Businesses and Other Premises) Regulations 2020² are amended as follows.
- (2) In Part 2 of the Schedule (businesses and premises that may remain open for restricted purposes) for the entry relating to “Garden retail shops”, substitute –

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made by the Governor in Council under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936 and following a proclamation of a state of emergency under section 3 of that Act.

These Regulations are made for the purpose of securing the essentials of life to the community of the Island and for the protection of the economy of the Island.

These Regulations amend the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Closure of Businesses and Other Premises) Regulations 2020 (“the principal regulations”) so as to enable garden centres to reopen from Monday 11 May 2020, subject to specific conditions where a garden centre includes a café.
