Emergency Powers Act 1936

EMERGENCY POWERS (PROHIBITIONS ON MOVEMENT) (AMENDMENT) (NO.5) REGULATIONS 2020

Laid before Tynwald: 19 May 2020
Approved by Tynwald: 19 May 2020
Coming into Operation: in accordance with regulation 2

The Governor in Council makes the following Regulations under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Emergency Powers (Prohibitions on Movement) (Amendment) (No.5) Regulations 2020.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made¹.

3 Emergency Powers (Prohibitions on Movement) Regulations 2020 amended

- (1) The Emergency Powers (Prohibitions on Movement) Regulations 2020² are amended as follows.
- (2) In regulation 3 (interpretation), for the definition of “leisure activities”, substitute —
 - ☐ “leisure activities” —
 - (a) does not include the participation in a sporting activity with persons who are not in the household of the person; but

- (b) includes —
- (i) visiting a friend or family member provided that a person does so in accordance with a direction made under the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) Regulations 2020³; and
 - (ii) an activity in a vessel (within the meaning of section 83(1) of the Harbours Act 2010) provided that in the case of a pleasure craft (as defined in that section), a person undertakes the activity in accordance with any guidance issued by the Department of Infrastructure for this purpose and which is published on www.gov.im.²²
- (3) In regulation 5 (exemptions from regulation 4: general) for regulation 5(7), substitute —
- ²³(7) Where this regulation permits a person to leave his or her ordinary place of residence for a purpose specified in paragraph (1) (“ exempt purpose”), the person is permitted to undertake any necessary travel in connection with that exempt purpose, provided that a person using private transport (including a taxi) may only share that private transport with members of his or her household, and in the case of a taxi, with members of his or her household and the driver;²²

4 Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) Regulations 2020 amended

In regulation 6(3) (procedure) of the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) Regulations 2020⁴, for “effected”, substitute ²⁴affected²².

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made by the Governor in Council under section 4 of the Emergency Powers Act 1936 and following a proclamation of a state of emergency under section 3 of that Act.

These Regulations are made for the purpose of securing the essentials of life to the community of the Island and for the protection of the economy of the Island.

These Regulations amend the Emergency Powers (Prohibitions on Movement) Regulations 2020 [SD 2020/0201] so as –

1. to clarify that a leisure activity includes (i) visiting a friend or family member, provided that a person doing so, complies with the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) Regulations 2020 and (ii) using a pleasure craft provided that the person doing so complies with guidance issued and published by the Department of Infrastructure.
2. to clarify that where, under regulation 5(1) a person is permitted to leave his or her place of residence, for a specified purpose, the person is permitted to undertake any necessary travel in connection with that purpose, subject to the existing restrictions regarding sharing private transport and taxis.

These regulations also amend the Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Events and Gatherings) Regulations 2020 [SD 2020/0185] so as to correct a typographical error in regulation 6(3).
