## **ELECTRONIC TRANSACTIONS (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2020**

*Approved by Tynwald: 22 July 2020  
Coming into Operation in accordance with regulation 2*

The Department for Enterprise makes the following Regulations under sections 1(3) and 8(1) of the Electronic Transactions 2000.

### **1 Title**

These Regulations are the Electronic Transactions (General) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2020.

### **2 Commencement**


If approved by Tynwald<sup>1</sup> these Regulations come into operation on 23 July 2020.

### **3 Amendment of Schedule to the Electronic Transactions (General) Regulations 2017<sup>2</sup>**

- (1) The Schedule to the Electronic Transactions (General) Regulations 2017 is amended as follows.
- (2) In the table, in the entry for the Department for Enterprise, in the column headed "Transaction", at the end, insert –
  8. The submission of information to the Department for Enterprise or the Registrar (as the case may be) under the following legislation –
    - a. the Partnership Act 1909;
    - b. the Registration of Business Names Act 1918;
    - c. the Companies Acts 1931 to 2004 (within the meaning of the Companies Act 2006);
    - d. the Credit Unions Act 1993;
    - e. the Limited Liability Companies Act 1996;

- f. the Companies Act 2006;
- g. the Foundations Act 2011;
- h. the Foreign Companies Act 2014; and
- i. the Industrial and Building Society Act 1892. .
