



## FORESTRY ACT 1984

### FORESTRY (GENERAL) BYELAWS (AMENDMENT) BYELAWS 2011

*Approved by Tynwald: 15 February 2011*

*Coming into operation: 1 March 2011*

The Department of Environment, Food and Agriculture makes these Byelaws under section 7 of the Forestry Act 1984<sup>1</sup>.

#### **1. Title**

The title of these Byelaws is the Forestry (General) Byelaws (Amendment) Byelaws 2011.

#### **2 Commencement**

If approved by Tynwald<sup>2</sup> these Byelaws come into operation on 1 March 2011.

#### **3 Amendment of the 2009 Byelaws**

(1) The Forestry (General) Byelaws 2009 shall be amended as follows.

(2) In byelaw 9 (dog fouling) for sub-paragraphs (1)(c) and (d) substitute –

“(c) a way-marked recreational route;

(d) a forest road;

(e) a car park or designated parking area;

(f) a picnic area;

(g) any mown or maintained areas of grass;

(h) any land within two metres of a path referred to in paragraph (a) or (b); and

(3) In Schedule 1 (land to which byelaw 8(3) applies at the end of that Schedule insert–

“Rushen Children’s play area at Bradda Glen”.

(4) In Schedule 2 (land to which byelaw 9 applies) -

(a) after the entry relating to “Tholt-y-Will Glen” insert –

“Lonan Conrhenny Plantation  
Axnfell Memorial Tree Planting Site”;

(b) after the entry relating to “Silverdale Glen” insert –

“South Barrule Plantation”.

(c) at the end insert –

“Rushen Bradda Glen”.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Byelaws.)*

These Byelaws amend the Forestry (General) Byelaws 2009.

Specifically they introduce additional areas vested in the Department where an offence is committed if an owner fails to remove any faeces deposited by his or her dog. These additional areas are:

- a way-marked recreational route;
- a forest road;
- a car park or designated parking area;
- a picnic area; and
- any mown or maintained area of grass.

An amendment is also made to extend the area of land adjacent to a path from one to two metres where dog foul must be removed by the owner.

Schedule 1 is amended to include the Children's Play Area at Bradda Glen as an area where dogs are not allowed.

Schedule 2 is amended to include plantations at South Barrule and Conrhenny along with the Axnfell Memorial Tree Planting Site and the whole of Bradda Glen as areas under which byelaw 9 is applicable.
