



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**A17 ST JUDES ROAD (LEZAYRE AND ANDREAS) (TEMPORARY
IMPOSITION OF 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011**

Coming into Operation: 31 January 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3(1) and section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

1 Title

This Order is the A17 St Judes Road (Lezayre and Andreas) (Temporary Imposition of 20 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 31 January 2011.

3 Temporary imposition of speed limit

No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel in excess of 20 mph on that section of the A17 St Judes Road, in Lezayre and Andreas, from a point adjacent to Sulby Bridge to a point approximately 100 metres north of St Judes crossroads.

4 Duration

This Order is in force from 6.00am on 31 January 2011 until 6.00pm on 31 March 2011 or until the water mains have been laid, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to temporarily impose a 20 mph speed limit on that section of the A17 St Judes Road, in Lezayre and Andreas, from a point adjacent to Sulby Bridge to a point approximately 100 metres north of St Judes crossroads, whilst water mains are being laid.

This Order is an extension to a previous temporary Order.
