



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

### CASTLE STREET (PEEL) (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2011

*Coming into Operation: 7 February 2011*

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>.

- 1 Title**  
This Order is the Castle Street (Peel) (Temporary Suspension of One-Way Traffic) Order 2011.
- 2 Commencement**  
This Order comes into operation at 9.00am on 7 February 2011.
- 3 Temporary amendment to principle Order**  
The provisions of paragraph 2 of Schedule 1 to the Various Roads (Peel) (One-Way Traffic) (Consolidation) Order 1999<sup>2</sup> with respect to one-way traffic on Castle Street, Peel, will be suspended between a point adjacent to the garage and the junction with Market Place.
- 4 Duration**  
This Order will be in force each day between 9.00am and 4.00pm from 7 February 2011 until 8 February 2011 or until the reinstatement work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
