



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

PEVERIL ROAD (PEEL) (TEMPORARY CLEARWAY) ORDER 2011

Coming into Operation: 7 February 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Peveril Road (Peel) (Temporary Clearway) Order 2011.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 7 February 2011.

3 Restriction of standing vehicles

No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to wait on that section of Peveril Road, Peel, between a point adjacent to the property 'Sea Point' and a point adjacent to the rear of property numbered 1 Ballaquane Road ('Geay Varrey').

4 Exemptions

Article 3 does not apply to a vehicle—

(a) waiting on the road specified in article 3 for so long as is necessary to enable the vehicle to be used in connection with—

- (i) any building operation or demolition;
- (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iii) the maintenance of such road;

- (iv) the repair in or near such road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as designed in the Telegraph Act 1878 (an Act of Parliament) as extended to the Isle of Man Telegraph (Isle of Man) Act 1889 (an Act of Parliament);
- (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (c) to a vehicle being used in the services of a local authority in pursuance of statutory power or duties;
- (d) to a vehicle being used for the purposes of delivery or collecting postal packets as defined in section 78 of the Isle of Man Post Office Authority (Postal Services etc.) Act 1973; or
- (e) to a vehicle waiting when the person in control of the vehicle—
 - (i) is required by law to stop;
 - (ii) is obliged to stop in order to avoid any accident; or
 - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.

5 Duration

This Order will continue in force from 6.00am on 7 February 2011 until 6.00pm on 2 April 2011 or until the carriageway reconstruction work in Derby Road is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicles from stopping on a section of Peveril Road, Peel, between the property 'Sea Point' and the rear of property numbered 1 Ballaquane Road ('Geay Varrey'), except where this is unavoidable or is required by law, or if permitted by the exercise of police discretion or where vehicles are engaged in specific statutory or emergency duties, so that the road is kept clear whilst buses use the route as a diversion during the carriageway reconstruction work taking place in Derby Road.
