



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

### THE RURAL ROADS (SPEED LIMITS) (TEMPORARY AMENDMENT) ORDER 2011

*Coming into Operation: 28 February 2011*

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3(1) and section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>.

- 1 Title**  
This Order is The Rural Roads (Speed Limits) (Temporary Amendment) Order 2011.
- 2 Commencement**  
This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 28 February 2011.
- 3 Temporary amendment to principle Order**  
For paragraph 5A of Schedule 2 to The Rural Roads (Speed Limits) Order 1979<sup>2</sup> substitute—

“In the Parishes of Braddan and Santon

(a) The Old Castletown Road (A25)

- (i) between its junction with the Douglas Town Boundary and a point 120 metres north of its junction with Marine Drive (A37) 50
- (ii) between a point 120 metres north of its junction with Marine Drive and the easternmost track leading to Ballamona Farm 40
- (iii) between the easternmost track leading to Ballamona Farm and the property Sea Cliff 30

(iv) between the property Sea Cliff and the junction with the 40" Castletown Road (A5) at the Blackboards

**4 Duration**

This Order is in force from 6.00am on 28 February 2011 until 6.00pm on 31 March 2011 or until the road safety work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to temporarily increase or decrease (as the case may be) the speed limits on that section of the Old Castletown Road, Braddan and Santon, between a point 120 metres north of its junction with the A37 Marine Drive and its junction with the A5 Castletown Road at the Blackboards, whilst road safety work takes place.

The temporary speed limits will be indicated by signs.

This Order is an extension to a previous temporary Order.
