



## CURRENCY ACT 1992

### CURRENCY (COMMONWEALTH YOUTH GAMES ) (2 POUND COINS) ORDER 2011

*Laid before Tynwald 15<sup>th</sup> March 2011*

*Coming into operation in accordance with article 2*

The Treasury makes this Order under section 5(1) (a), (b) and (d) of the Currency Act 1992<sup>1</sup>.

**1 Title**

This Order is the Currency (Commonwealth Youth Games) (2 Pound Coins) Order 2011.

**2 Commencement**

This Order comes into operation on the day after it is made.

**3 Interpretation**

In this Order "Commonwealth Youth Games coin" means any coin that —

(a) bears the number 2 on the reverse; and

(b) is issued to commemorate the Commonwealth Youth Games .

**4 Denomination of Commonwealth Youth Games coins**

The permissible denomination of a Commonwealth Youth Games coin is two pounds.

**5 Face value of Commonwealth Youth Games coins**

The face value of a Commonwealth Youth Games coin is two pounds.

**6 Design of Commonwealth Youth Games coins**

- (1) Each coin will be circular with a milled edge.
- (2) On the obverse of a coin there shall be —
  - (a) an effigy of Her Majesty the Queen by Ian Rank-Broadley in the centre
  - (b) the legend “ISLE OF MAN ELIZABETH II”; around the effigy
  - (c) the year of issue below the effigy

On the reverse of the coin there shall be-

An image depicting the official Commonwealth Youth Games Mascot, Tosha The Cat along with the official logo of the games. The catchy name, Tosha, has the appropriate Manx Gaelic meaning of ‘First’. The value appears at the bottom of the coin.

**7 Weight, composition, dimension and amount of tolerance and variation of Commonwealth Youth Games coins**

The following table shall apply to Commonwealth Youth Games coins in respect of the matters for which it provides —

It also prescribes the device to be borne by such coins.
