



ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1985

**MOTOR CARS (DRIVING INSTRUCTORS) (FEES)  
REGULATIONS 2011**

*Approved by Tynwald*                      15 March 2011

*Coming into operation*                      1 April 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes these Regulations under section 74(1) and (2) of, and paragraphs 5(1), 6(1), 8(2A) and 10(1)(c) of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Act 1985<sup>1</sup>.

**1 Title**

These Regulations are the Motor Cars (Driving Instructors) (Fees) Regulations 2011.

**2 Commencement**

Subject to Tynwald approval<sup>2</sup>, these Regulations come into operation on 1 April 2011.

**3 Interpretation**

In these Regulations –

"the Act" means the Road Traffic Act 1985; and

a reference to –

- (a) the examination or a part of it,
- (b) a temporary licence, or
- (c) the theory test,

has the same meaning as in the Motor Cars (Driving Instructors) Regulations 2007<sup>3</sup>.

#### 4 Fees

The fee to be paid by a person who applies in respect of a matter mentioned in an item in column 2 of the following table shall be the amount specified in that item in column 3.

1. These Regulations, which replace similar Regulations of 2007, prescribe the fees to be paid when applications are made in respect of certain specified matters under the Motor Cars (Driving Instructors) Regulations 2007.
  
  2. The prescribed fees are intended to cover the Department of Infrastructure's current costs in administering the registration or licensing of motor-car driving instructors under the Road Traffic Act 1985.
