



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

### THE BAYRRUYR (B30) (MALEW) (TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2011

*Coming into Operation: 21 February 2011*

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>.

**1 Title**

This Order is The Bayrruyr (B30) (Malew) (Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2011.

**2 Commencement**

This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 21 February 2011.

**3 Temporary weight restriction**

Subject to article 4, no person must cause any vehicle the weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes laden and unladen to proceed on that section of The Bayrruyr (B30) in Malew, from its junction with Cordeman Road to its junction with the Ballamodha Straight.

**4 Exemptions**

Article 3 does not apply to—

- (a) an emergency services vehicle;
- (b) a vehicle requiring access to properties;
- (c) a Department of Infrastructure vehicle being used in connection with works on the road; or
- (d) such other exemptions that the Department may authorise in writing;

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to impose a temporary weight restriction of 7.5 tonnes laden and unladen on a section of The Bayrruyr (B30) in Malew, from its junction with Cordeman Road to its junction with the Ballamodha Straight.

An alternative route for HGVs will be via Crosby or Ballasalla.
