



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

UNNAMED LANE TO REAR OF DERBY ROAD (PEEL) (TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF 10 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011

Coming into Operation: 24 February 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3(1) and section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Unnamed Lane to Rear of Derby Road (Peel) (Temporary Imposition of 10 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 24 February 2011.

3 Temporary imposition of speed limit

No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel in excess of 10 mph on that section of the unnamed lane to the rear of Derby Road, Peel, from its junction with Albany Road to a point adjacent to the rear of No 34 Derby Road.

4 Duration

This Order is in force from 6.00am on 24 February 2011 until 6.00pm on 2 April 2011 or until the carriageway reconstruction work in Derby Road is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not a part of the Order)

This Order effects the temporary imposition of a 10 mph speed limit on that section of the unnamed lane to the rear of Derby Road, Peel, from its junction with Albany Road to a point adjacent to the rear of No 34 Derby Road, whilst carriageway reconstruction work takes place in Derby Road.
