



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

UNNAMED LANE TO REAR OF DERBY ROAD (PEEL) (TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2011

Coming into Operation: 24 February 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

- 1 Title**
This Order is the Unnamed Lane to Rear of Derby Road (Peel) (Temporary Imposition of One-Way Traffic) Order 2011.
- 2 Commencement**
This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 24 February 2011.
- 3 Temporary imposition of one-way traffic**
No person must cause any vehicle to travel otherwise than in an easterly direction only on that section of the unnamed lane to the rear of Derby Road, Peel, from its junction with Albany Road to a point adjacent to the rear of No 34 Derby Road.
- 4 Duration**
This Order will be in force from 6.00am on 24 February 2011 until 6.00pm on 2 April 2011 or until the carriageway reconstruction work in Derby Road is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to temporarily impose a one-way traffic system on a section of Derby Road, Peel, from its junction with Albany Road to a point adjacent to the rear of No 34 Derby Road, whilst carriageway reconstruction work takes place in Derby Road.
