



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

A13 RAMSEY TO CRONK ROAD AND A17 SULBY BRIDGE TO BRIDE ROAD, ST JUDES (ANDREAS) (TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2011

Coming into Operation: 28 February 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3(1) and section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

1 Title

This Order is the A13 Ramsey to Cronk Road and A17 Sulby Bridge to Bride Road, St Judes (Andreas) (Temporary Imposition of 20 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 28 February 2011.

3 Temporary imposition of speed limit

No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel in excess of 20 mph on those sections of roads in Andreas as set out in the Schedule.

4 Duration

This Order is in force from 6.00am on 28 February 2011 until 6.00pm on 6 March 2011 or until Phase I of the water mains laying work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

SCHEDULE

The A13 Ramsey to Cronk Road, St Judes, from a point adjacent to the Old Parsonage to a point approximately 170 metres west of St Judes crossroads.

The A17 Sulby Bridge to Bride Road, St Judes, from its junction with St Judes crossroads for a distance of approximately 150 metres in a northerly direction.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

This Order effects the temporary imposition of a 20 mph speed limit on those sections of roads as set out in the Schedule, whilst Phase I of the water mains laying work takes place.
