(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2011**

Coming into Operation: 7 March 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3(1) and section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Heywood Drive, Heywood Way, Heywood Close, Heywood Grove and Heywood Avenue (Onchan) (Temporary Imposition of 20 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 7 March 2011.

3 Temporary imposition of speed limit

No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel at a speed in excess of 20 mph on the whole length of Heywood Drive, Heywood Way, Heywood Close, Heywood Grove and Heywood Avenue, Onchan.

4 Duration

This Order is in force from 6.00am on 7 March 2011 until 6.00pm on 7 September 2011 or until the construction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
