**B16 GLEN AULDYN ROAD (LEZAYRE)
(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2011**

Coming into Operation: 14 March 2011

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3(1) and section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹.

- 1 Title**
This Order is the B16 Glen Auldyn Road (Lezayre) (Temporary Imposition of 20 Mph Speed Limit) Order 2011.
- 2 Commencement**
This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 14 March 2011.
- 3 Temporary imposition of speed limit**
No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel in excess of 20 mph on the B16 Glen Auldyn Road, Lezayre, from its junction with the A3 Lezayre Road for the whole of its length.
- 4 Duration**
This Order is in force from 6.00am on 14 March 2011 until 6.00pm on 14 September 2011 or until the construction work on the Ramsey Service Reservoir is completed, whichever is the earlier.
