



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

### **BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (PROSPECT HILL) (TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES AND BUS STOP) ORDER 2011**

*Coming into Operation: 14 March 2011*

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>.

**1 Title**

This Order is the Borough of Douglas (Prospect Hill) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places and Bus Stop) Order 2011.

**2 Commencement**

This Order comes into operation at 6.00am on 14 March 2011.

**3 Temporary suspension of parking places and bus stop**

No person must cause any vehicle to be parked on—

(a) either side of that section of Prospect Hill, Douglas, between its junction with Hill Street and its junction with St George's Walk, including the disabled persons' vehicles parking place and the bus stop situated outside Hillary House; and

(b) the disabled persons' vehicles parking place situated outside Victory House.

**4 Amendment to principle Order**

The Schedule to the Borough of Douglas Traffic Regulations Consolidation Order 1981 (No 1)<sup>2</sup> is amended by temporarily revoking the provisions of paragraph 33A(ii) relating the Prospect Hill.

5 **Exemptions**

Article 3(b) does not apply to a public passenger vehicle that is constructed or adapted to carry more than 16 passengers in addition to the driver.

6 **Duration**

This Order is in force from 6.00am on 14 March 2011 until 6.00pm on 28 March 2011 or until the road reconstruction work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not a part of the Order)*

The effect of this Order is to suspend parking on both sides of that section of Prospect Hill, Douglas, between its junction with Hill Street and its junction with St George's Walk, including the disabled persons' vehicles parking place and the bus stop situated outside Hillary House and (except for buses) the disabled persons' vehicles parking place situated outside Victory House, whilst road reconstruction work takes place.
