



## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

### **A3 BALLACRAINE TO RAMSEY ROAD (KIRK MICHAEL) (TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF 30 MPH AND 50 MPH SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2011**

*Coming into Operation: 14 March 2011*

The Department of Infrastructure makes this Order under section 3(1) and section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>.

- 1 Title**  
This Order is the A3 Ballacraine to Ramsey Road (Kirk Michael) (Temporary Imposition of 30 Mph and 50 Mph Speed Limits) Order 2011.
- 2 Commencement**  
This Order comes into operation at 9.00am on 14 March 2011.
- 3 Temporary imposition of speed limits**  
No person must except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel in excess of 30 mph and 50 mph as indicated by signs, on that section of the A3 Ballacraine to Ramsey Road, Kirk Michael, between the Barregarrow crossroads and the property 'Keil Vain'.
- 4 Duration**  
This Order is in force from 9.00am on 14 March 2011 until 6.00pm on 2 April 2011 or until the carriageway surfacing work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

The effect of this Order is impose 30 mph and 50 mph speed limits as indicated by signs, on that section of the A3 Ballacraigne to Ramsey Road (Douglas Road), Kirk Michael, between the Barregarrow crossroads and the property 'Keel Vain', whilst carriageway surfacing work takes place.
