**1 Title**

This Order is the Motor Bicycles (Approved Training Courses for Drivers) (Fees) Order 2011.

**2 Commencement**

Subject to Tynwald approval<sup>2</sup>, this Order comes into operation on 1 June 2011.

**3 Fees**


**4 Revocation**

EXPLANATORY NOTE  
*(This note is not part of the Order)*

This Order prescribes the fees to be paid for certain tests, extensions of authorisations, reviews, and duplicates or forms of certificates under the Motor Bicycles (Approved Training Courses for Drivers) Regulations 2002.

The prescribed fees are intended to cover the Department of Infrastructure's current costs in administering the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1985 relating to compulsory basis training courses for learner drivers of motor bicycles.
