



## EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (ISLE OF MAN) ACT 1973

### LIBYA SANCTIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2011

*Laid before Tynwald*                      *12 April 2011*  
*Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 2*

The Council of Ministers makes these Regulations under section 2B of the European Communities (Isle of Man) Act 1973<sup>1</sup>.

#### **1 Title**

These Regulations are the Libya Sanctions (Amendment) Regulations 2011.

#### **2 Commencement**

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made.

#### **3 Amendment of the Libya Sanctions Regulations 2011**

In regulation 1(2) of the Libya Sanctions Regulations 2011<sup>2</sup> for the definition of “the EU Regulation” substitute—

““the EU Regulation” means Council Regulation (EU) No 204/2011<sup>3</sup> of 2 March 2011 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya, as amended by Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 233/2011<sup>4</sup> of 10 March 2011 implementing Article 16(2) of Regulation (EU) No 204/2011 concerning restrictive measures in view of the situation in Libya, as these instruments have effect in the Island<sup>5</sup>”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations amend the Libya Sanctions Regulations 2011 to take account of the amendment of the European Union (Libya Sanctions) (Application) Order 2011 (SD 157/11) by the European Union (Libya Sanctions) (Application) (Amendment) Order 2011 (SD 168/11). The 2011 Regulations established offences and penalties for breaches of Council Regulation (EU) No. 204/2011, as applied to the Island by SD 157/11, and they provided for the licensing by the Treasury of certain activities.
