TRANSFER OF FUNCTIONS (TRAFFIC WARDENS) ORDER 2011

*Approved by Tynwald
Coming into operation*

*12th April 2011
1st May 2011*

The Governor in Council makes this Order under Schedule 2 to the Government Departments Act 1987¹.

1 Title

This Order is the Transfer of Functions (Traffic Wardens) Order 2011.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald², this Order comes into operation on 1 May 2011.

3 Transfer of power to appoint and employ traffic wardens

The power of the Department of Home Affairs under section 33 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985³ to appoint and employ persons as traffic wardens (within the meaning of subsection (2) of that section) is transferred to the Department of Infrastructure.

4 Consequential amendments

(1) In subsection (1) (in both places where it occurs) and subsections (2), (3), (7) and (8) of section 33 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 for "Department of Home Affairs" substitute "Department".

(2) In Part II of Schedule 1 to the Civil Service Act 1990⁴ –

(a) delete paragraph 2(b) apart from "or";

(b) after paragraph 2 insert –

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order transfers the power of the Department of Home Affairs under section 33 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 to appoint and employ persons as traffic wardens to the Department of Infrastructure. Consequential amendments are made to the provision in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 that deals with the appointment of traffic wardens and the provision in the Civil Service Act 1990 that provides for them not to be civil servants.
