



THE PAYMENT OF MEMBERS' EXPENSES ACT 1989

THE MEMBERS OF TYNWALD (ANNUAL EXPENSES) ORDER 1998

Approved by Tynwald

28 April 1998

Coming into operation 15th July 1997

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by sections 3, 6 and 7 of the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the body designated for the purpose of section 6 (3) of that Act, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Members of Tynwald (Annual Expenses) Order 1998 and, subject to section 7(4) of the Act, shall be deemed to have come into operation on 15th July, 1997.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989.

Annual payments to members of Tynwald

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the annual sum prescribed for the purpose of section 3 of the Act (annual payments by way of expenses of members of Tynwald) shall be £3,906.63.

(2) In each year from 1st August 1997, the annual sum payable under paragraph 2(1) shall be increased cumulatively each year by the average percentage increase applied to the salaries of officers in the General Service Classes of the Civil Service.
